Common Name: Spring Onion

Scientific Name: Allium Fistulosum

Family: Allium

Requirements

Season: Summer

Sun: Partial shade

Water: Well drained. Water well.

Climate: Tropical- sensitive to cold (place indoors during winter by sunny window).

Soil Notes: Shallow roots. Prepare with rock minerals, organic soil conditioner. 5mm deep, 15cm apart in rows. Hummus rich. PH 6-7 (add lime to acidic soil or sulphur to alkaline soil). Liquid fertiliser (Worm pea or diluted seaweed or fish emulsion)

Harvest Time : After 8-12weeks.

Compatible: Lemon Balm, Borage, Carrots, Beetroot, Lettuce- NOT GROWN WITH PEAS or BEANS

INTERESTING NOTES:

Can regrow leave 1cm of onion behind- leave stem out of water.

Succession plant every 3-4 weeks for continual harvest
